## <u>APPLICATION INFORMATION</u>

- 1. A plan of the property accurately showing all the sewer laterals in relationship to the District's Interceptor connection.
- 2. Plans, details, and specifications covering any work proposed to be performed in making the interceptor connection under this application.
- 3. If industrial wastes are expected to be discharged to the District's interceptor from this property then the industry must contact the District to apply for an Industrial Discharge Permit.
- 4. Documentation of access to the District's interceptor easement to make the connection such as ownership, public easement, agreement with owner, etc.

## AGREEMENT

In consideration of the approval of this application, the undersigned agrees to the following where Town refers to the Town in which the connection is being made.

- 1. To accept and abide by all provisions of the Charles River Pollution Control District "Sewer Use Regulations" and the Town's sewer ordinances and all other pertinent ordinances or regulations that may be adopted in the future.
- 2. To conform to the requirements of the Building and Plumbing code or other applicable rules and regulations of the District and Town for the size, slope, alignment, materials or construction of a building sewer, and the methods to be used in excavating, placing of the pipe, jointing, testing and backfilling the trench. In the absence of code provisions or in amplification thereof, the materials and procedures set forth in appropriate specifications of the A.S.T.M. and W.P.C.F. Manual of Practice No. 9 shall apply.
- 3. To conform to the requirements of the Building and Plumbing code or other applicable rules and regulations of the District and relevant Town, or the procedures set forth in appropriate specifications of the A.S.T.M. and the W.P.C.F. Manual of Practice No. 9. All connections shall be made gastight and watertight. Any deviation from the prescribed procedures and materials must be approved by the Director and the Town before installation.
- 4. To adequately guarded with barricades and lights all excavations to protect the public.
- 5. To restore any streets, sidewalks, parkways, and other property disturbed in the course of the work in a manner satisfactory to the District and the Town.
- 6. To furnish any additional information relating to the installation or the use of the sewer lateral for which this application is sought as requested by the District or the Town.
- 7. To cooperate at all times with the District and the Town and its representatives in their inspection, sampling, and study of its connection, wastewater discharge and any facilities required for pretreatment.
- 8. To notify the District and the Town immediately in the event of any accident, negligence or other occurrence that occasions discharge to the public sewers of any wastes of process waters not covered by this application.
- 9. To notify the District at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the connection and disturbing of any District sewage works to allow supervision and inspection of the connection by the District or its representative.
- 10. To allow access to private property for purpose of inspection.
- 11. To pay District fees for filing this application and the inspection of the work covered under this application.
- 12. To pay all costs and expenses incident to the installation and connection of the building sewer to the District's sewer interceptor

- 13. To indemnify the District and the Town from any loss or damage that may directly or indirectly be occasioned by the installation or connection of the building sewer.
- 14. To maintain the sewer service at no expense to the District. Sewer service lines become the full responsibility of owner.
- 15. To not allow any connection of roof downspouts, exterior foundation drains, areaway drains, or other sources of surface runoff or ground water to a building sewer or building drain which in turn is connected directly or indirectly to a District sewer interceptor.
- 16. To not allow any use of property's sewer service connection for any purpose other than its intended use for the conveyance of wastewater from my property to the public sewer.

These requirements and regulations are subject to change per the discretion of the Charles River Pollution Control District.
